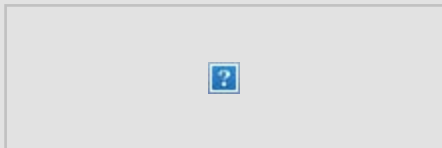

He has an extensive background in Project Management, large-scale IT Systems Implementation, IT Infrastructure, Enterprise Business Reengineering, and Systems Integration.

Jimenez has a MA in Computers and Information Systems from Missouri's Webster University, a MS in Acquisition Management from Florida Institute of Technology (Florida Tech) in Melbourne, and a BS in Business Management from St. Mary's University in San Antonio.
