Please see our response to your inquiries as follows:

I understand that at the County meeting last week it was requested to award this project to IP Logic. We feel we met all critical requirements along with being low bid.

In response to your e-mail, no decision has been made as to the award of the VoIP-Enabling Data Network Upgrade RFP. I am unclear as to what meeting a request to award was made.
